At the August general meeting we need approval of the membership to purchase the following:

Three (3) Type II P. F. D's, Ensolute filled.

\$6.10 each

Six (6) Mohawk or equivalent type and priced canoe paddles.

\$12.00/EA *72.00*

About 60' rope for tying down canoes to vehicle, fore and aft.

3/8" twisted nylon 3.181 ft

I estimate a cash layout of about \$125.00 for all of the above.

We only have three (3) type II jackets left. They are the kapok filled type and I suspect these will also need replacing before the end of this year.

Although our wooden canoe paddles are adequate they are not efficient. These paddles would better serve as spares.

Most Club members renting boats do not have any tie down rope. Pat and I, in most cases, have been furnishing this item, but is not always available from us.


At a later date we need to consider replacing the aluminum gunnels on one of the Club boats. Although the hull is in very good shape, the boat is out of line and looks tacky.

A set of gunnels cost \$70.00. I generally charge \$64.00 for installation; 8 hours at \$8.00 per hour. However, since I am on the Board of Governors, and if I do the work, the labor charge will be waived, provided I can get a volunteer to help with the work.


